Our other option is a 25 Meal Block Plan! You can purchase 25 meals. These meals are valid for breakfast, lunch, dinner, and brunch. (\$150.00 tax included)

It really pays to be on a meal plan! Selection of a Campus Dining Services Meal Plan entitles you to a Meal Card, which allows you purchasing power equivalent to the plan you have selected.

What is an ID/ Meal Card?

It is your permanent student ID card plus a debit card for food services on campus. Each time you make a purchase, the amount of the purchase is deducted from your accounts' balance.

Using Your Card

Who can use my card?

For your protection, the only person authorized to use your card is you. For that reason, Meal Plan Meals are non-transferable.
